

CAMP OPTIONS: If you have any questions as to which Camp to attend, the T.A.B.C. recommends consulting your son or daughter's high school or junior high school coach. ALL campers attending the T.A.B.C. Camp of Champs will have many opportunities to participate in competitive individual and team play. Your son or daughter is encouraged to come with teammates from their hometown or school. They will be able to get better together while competing in team competition at camp.

FUNDAMENTAL CAMP (Girls Only) - This Camp is dedicated to developing the all-around individual offensive and defensive skills of every player. Campers attending this camp have not yet competed at the junior varsity level. The Fundamental Camp is for girls ages 8-14.

HS TEAM/SPECIALTY CAMP - This Camp is for players on the junior varsity or Varsity high school level, ages 14-18. Those not yet in high school need their coach's recommendation. This camp is devoted to more specific position development and is ideal as a team camp for players from the same school. Participants will get to work on skill development AND team competitions.

SKILLS SHOWCASE (Boys Only) - This camp is for boys ages 8-14. At this camp, the campers will work to develop individual offensive and defensive skills. The campers will participate in daily skill development as well as numerous competitive situations and games.

SHOOTING CAMP (Boys Only) - This camp is for boys ages 9-16. This camp's focus is on all aspects of shooting the basketball from mechanics and form to ball fakes and bank shots. Along with daily skill development, the campers will also compete in various games and competitions.

CAMP LOCATION: All T.A.B.C. Camps (Boys and Girls) will be held on the beautiful campus of Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas. Located just 45 minutes north of Austin on I-35, Southwestern University provides the T.A.B.C. Camp of Champs with a centrally located Camp site in the scenic city of Georgetown. The campers will stay in the dormitories, while eating all meals in the recently upgraded state-of-art cafeteria. All basketball activities will take place in the Robertson Gymnasium athletic complex. Southwestern University provides the T.A.B.C. Camps with the best amenities of any basketball camp in the state of Texas.

From Interstate 35 take Exit #261 (Texas Highway 29). Follow Highway 29 east (University Avenue) approximately 1.3 miles, turn left onto Southwestern Blvd. The gym is the second building on the left.

TRANSPORTATION TO CAMP: It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to arrange transportation to and from camp for their son or daughter. T.A.B.C. will provide transportation to and from the Austin Bergstrom Airport for \$30 round trip or \$15 one way. Please set this up with the camp director or the T.A.B.C. office.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT: Check-In for each camp will run from 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. in the lobby of Robertson Gymnasium on the campus of Southwestern University. Campers will receive all necessary information regarding Camp, housing and meals at that time. The 1st Day of Camp will begin at approximately 12:00 Noon. Campers must provide their own lunch on the 1st Day of Camp and need to eat lunch before the start of camp. Camp ends daily at 10 p.m. except the last day when it ends at 4 p.m. Day campers need to arrive at 8:00 a.m. the second and third day. They must eat breakfast before camp starts. EXCEPTION: SHOOTING CAMP REGISTRATION RUN FROM 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. CAMP WILL START AT 5:00 p.m. SHOOTING CAMP WILL END AT 5PM ON THE LAST DAY.

CAMP TUITION: You can reserve your spot by sending your camp application and a \$50 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit. The remaining balance and a Southwestern waiver form should be sent to TABC 2 weeks before the camp starts. If using a credit card, you must pay the full amount up front when you register. Your confirmation, the waiver, a map to Southwestern and a detailed list of items to bring to camp will be sent out within two weeks after we receive your application and deposit.
